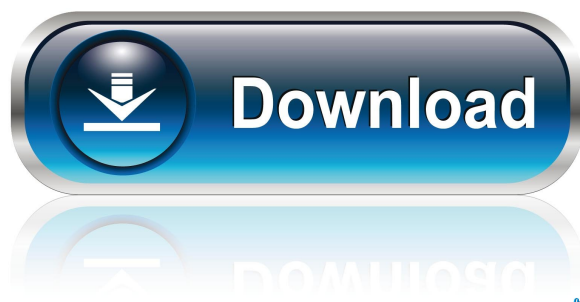

For the past couple of months I've been developing websites for clients with local hosting. A couple of weeks ago I did some changes to a website and eventually to a favicon.ico file on a webserver. While I was developing that website I'd run `ls -l` on the file to check the size and it was showing the size as the right one. However, when I transfered the website to production server, the icons were way smaller than before, and to check if it has something to do with the file size, I ran the `ls` command again and it shows an unexpected output: `-rw-r--r-- 1 root root 6 Apr 17 22:15 favicon.ico -rw-r--r-- 1 root root 848 Oct 19 23:10 favicon.ico` Now the two files are exactly the same, and both are named favicon.ico. Both files also have the same size (as shown by the `ls -l` command). Why did my favicon.ico file change its name to a PHP file? A: That happens to any image files that are "compressed" in an archive format (tar, zip, etc.) In this case it is likely that the server configured PHP to wrap any text file in a PHP tag in the process of compression. I'd just remove the file, as it's not doing you any good. I can't imagine that some business process needs it run. Alternatively, you can use the `file` command to see the actual content of a file in more detail. The `-i` flag will show you the contents of the file, including the content of embedded archive files. } !
